In the instant petition, petitioners are seeking quashing of FIR No. 0098 dated 05.04.2016 under Sections 326, 323, 506, 148, 149 IPC registered at Police Station A-Division District Amritsar (Annexure P-1) and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise/affidavit (Annexures P2 and P3) arrived at between the parties.

2. The present FIR is an outcome of sudden quarrel and now it has been resolved among parties and sought for quashing of FIR in view of compromise.

3. This Court by the order dated 06.07.2018 had directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court for recording their statements with regard to veracity of the compromise. The Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Amritsar has sent his report dated 10.08.2018 wherein it is stated that in pursuance to the order of this Court, statements of the parties were recorded and compromise has been effected without any fear or undue influence.

4. In view of the law laid down in “*Narinder Singh Vs. State of*

Punjab” 2014 (6) SCC 466, no useful purpose will be served by continuing the criminal proceedings. Therefore, the petition is allowed and FIR No. 0098 dated 05.04.2016 under Sections 326, 323, 506, 148, 149 IPC registered at Police Station A-Division District Amritsar (Annexure P-1) and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed against the petitioners subject to payment of litigation cost of Rs.3000/- by each of the petitioner to State of Punjab. Cost shall be remitted in the Treasury, State of Punjab within a period of 3 months from today.
