Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that a minor altercation took place between both the parties, therefore, police has recommended the deletion of offences under Sections 452, 326, 148 and 149 of the IPC. The SHO, Police Station Jandiala had prepared the untraced report but not filing the same before the trial Court by taking benefit of the pendency of the present petition.

In view of above, this petition is dismissed as withdrawn.

The untraced report be submitted within a period of two weeks. In case the untraced report is not submitted within two weeks, the petitioner will be at liberty to revive this petition.
