The petitioners seek quashing of Report No.15 dated 17.02.2013 under Sections 323, 341, 506, 148 and 149 in FIR No. 25 dated 12.02.2013 Police Station Kalanaur, District Gurdaspur and proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.

Vide order dated 06.07.2018 the parties had been directed to

appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate so as to get the statements recorded with regard to the genuineness of the compromise.

Report of learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Gurdaspur has been received to the effect that that statements of the complainant- Gurdeep Singh and also of the accused namely Rajesh Kumar, Laxmi Vohra, Ashok, Amarjit, Rohit, Kulwant Rai, Pardeep Kumar, Rinku, Niti Vij @ Narinder Vij, Ashwani Kumar, Ajay Joshi have been recorded who have stated that they have compromised the matter with the intervention of respectable of the locality and have no objection in case the FIR is quashed. It has specifically been opined by learned Magistrate that the parties have entered into the compromise without any pressure, coercion or any undue influence.

In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the petition is allowed and Report No.15 dated 17.02.2013 under Sections 323, 341, 506, 148 and 149 in FIR No. 25 dated 12.02.2013 Police Station Kalanaur, District Gurdaspur and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed.
