The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.55 dated 13.05.2018 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 148, 149, 342, 365 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Mohana, District Sonapat.

Heard.

It is a case of prosecution that on 12th May, 2018 at about 4 o'clock, petitioner along with his associates has caused injuries on the person of Sunil and Manobal. Sunil suffered grievous injuries and Manobal received simple injuries. Petitioner is in custody since 13th May, 2018. Nothing has to be recovered from him. Challan has already been submitted.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that conclusion of trial will take considerably long time, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner Bijender alias Bije son of

Dayanand is ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of trial court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned subject to following terms:-

- (a) The petitioner shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.
- (b) In the event of his absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioner shall stand withdrawn. The trial court shall be competent to cancel his bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure his presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioner shall have to apply for bail afresh.
- (c) He shall not leave the country without the previous permission of the court.
