Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.172 dated 20.06.2018 registered under Section 61 of Punjab Excise Act, 1914 at Police Station City Sangrur, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 09.07.2018 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation. He further states that there is no other case against the petitioner.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Satpal Singh, does not dispute the aforesaid fact and states that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is no more required at this stage.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no more required, present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 09.07.2018 is made absolute.

However, during the period of current excise policy i.e. 2018-19 formulated by the State of Punjab, the petitioner shall report to the SHO, Police Station City Sangrur on 3rd of every month and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
