In the instant petition, petitioner has sought for regular bail under the provision of Section 439 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.76 dated 06.02.2017 under Sections 307, 323, 379 of IPC and Section 302 of IPC (added later on) registered at Police Station Sadar Fatehabad, District Fatehabad.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is aged about 80 years and he is in custody since 11.02.2017. It is also submitted that complainant has been examined.

3. These facts are not disputed by learned State counsel.

4. Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances as stated above by learned counsel for the parties and the fact that the petitioner is aged about 80 years and he is in custody since 11.02.2017 and the complainant has been examined, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. Petitioner, namely, Ram Singh is ordered to be

released on regular bail on his furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of concerned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.

6. However, the petitioner shall not in any way indulge in any criminal activities and he shall also not influence the witnesses or other wise interfere with the fair trial.
