Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the official respondents to investigate the matter through some higher official of the police or Crime Branch or any other independent agency in FIR No.65 dated 25.03.2018 under Sections 323, 341, 506, 148 and 149 IPC registered at Police Station Derabassi.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that for the relief claimed in the present petition, the petitioner has already submitted a representation dated 08.06.2018 (Annexure P-2) to the respondent No.2 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar (Mohali) and he would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to consider the said representation at this stage.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only at this stage.

On asking of this Court, Mr. Rana Harjasdeep Singh, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of these respondents.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Considering the limited prayer of learned counsel for the petitioner and without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into the representation (Annexure P-2) and to act in accordance with law.
