In the instant petition, petitioners have sought for regular bail under the provision of Section 439 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No. 175 dated 28.05.2018, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324, 379-B, 435, 452 & 506 of the IPC registered at Police Station Madlauda, Panipat.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the petitioners are in custody since 02.06.2018. It is also submitted that they are not involved in any other case.

3. Learned State counsel filed reply to the bail application and the same is taken on record. Undisputedly, petitioners are not involved in any other case.

4. Heard the learned counsel for the parties.

5. In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioners, especially having regard to the fact that petitioners are not involved in any other case, I deem it appropriate to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioners.

6. Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. Petitioners-Jitender @ Zinna and Manoj are ordered to be released on regular bail on their furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
