The present petition was filed for seeking protection on behalf of the petitioners. However, petitioner No.1 is not present in the Court to own the fact that she has filed this petition. Therefore, no order qua the petitioner No.1 need to be passed in the present petition. So far as the petitioner No.2 is concerned, he is present in the Court and he had claimed that he had got married with petitioner No.1. However, that marriage was not to the liking of the parents of the girl. On account of this, the petitioner apprehends threat to his liberty and liberty. However, so far as the petitioner No.2 is concerned, he has not approached the police authorities with any such apprehension.

Be that as it may. Since it is a question of protection of life and liberty, therefore, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to ensure that no harm is caused to petitioner No.2 in an illegal manner. In case petitioner No.2 approaches respondent No.2 with a complaint then respondent No.2 is directed to look into the complaint filed by petitioner No.2.

However, it is made clear that anything said in this order shall not be remotely taken as any validation of the alleged marriage, as

claimed by the petitioner, nor shall this order be treated as an embargo by the police authorities against taking any other action in accordance with law, if petitioner No.2 is liable for any such action.
