Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.182 dated 15.06.2017 registered under Sections 15, 25 of NDPS Act and Section 120-B of IPC at Police Station Taraori, District Karnal.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Dalbir Singh, states that the petitioner has been declared proclaimed offender vide order dated 30.07.2018.

In view of the fact that the earlier anticipatory bail petition i.e. CRM-M-33303-2017 has been dismissed as withdrawn vide order dated 03.10.2017 passed by this Court, this Court finds that the present petition also deserves to be dismissed as the petitioner has been declared proclaimed offender.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that since the petitioner had also approached this Court for grant of anticipatory bail and the PO order having been passed after filing of present petition, has no effect as the petitioner was pursuing the remedy under law, but since the earlier petition was dismissed as withdrawn by this Court on 03.10.2017, the plea of the petitioner that he has been declared PO after filling of the present petition, cannot be accepted.
