The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 75 dated 26.05.2018, under Sections 406, 420 and 120-B of the IPC, registered at Police Station Fatehgarh Sahib, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

The operative part of the order dated 06.07.2018, vide which the petitioner has been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Counsel for the petitioner submits that as per the allegations in the FIR (Annexure P1), the main allegations are levelled against Simranjit Singh, brother of the petitioner, Parneet Kaur wife of Simranjit Singh and Charanjeet Singh, father of petitioner that they are running a business of finance at Sirhind and used to run committees of various groups of persons and the complainants have invested the money in the same. Counsel for the petitioner further submits that there are no direct allegations against the petitioner except that he is brother of the aforesaid main accused Simranjit Singh. Counsel further submits that the petitioner is an ordinary residence of Sunam and has relied upon certain

documents (Annexures P2 and P3 (colly) i.e. Vat number of shop, registration certificate, Pan Card, Ration Card, Voter Card, Marriage Certificate, Aadhar Card etc. Counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner has no connection with the business run by aforesaid Simranjit Singh and he has also given complaint to Senior Superintendent of Police, Fatehgarh Sahib that complainants are harassing him without his involvement. Counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner is ready to join investigation and submit all the documents showing that he is not a part of the business run by accused Simranjit Singh and others.

Notice of motion for 16.10.2018. ”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 06.07.2018, has already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Narinder Singh, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 06.07.2018, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
