This petition has been filed under Section 438 for grant of anticipatory bail in the FIR No. 39 dated 19.03.2015 under Section 67/71 of Information Technology Act, 2000 and 498-A IPC registered at Police Station Anandpur Sahib, District Rupnagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contend that the petitioner has wrongly been implicated in the afore-said FIR and has been facing trial regularly, however, due to some exigency and emergency, could not put an appearance before the Court.

An application of exemption for appearance was filed which was declined and arrest warrants were issued against him for 19.07.2018. The petitioner applied for grant of anticipatory bail and the same stood dismissed and the petitioner was directed to appear before the trial Court

and move an application for grant of regular bail which is to be decided within a period of two days.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner would appear before the trial Court/Duty Magistrate on or before 12.07.2018 and in case he files a regular bail application, the same be decided by the trial Court on the same day itself.

I have heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and while taking note of the order so passed, I deem it appropriate to modify the order dated 05.06.2018 to the extent that in case the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court/Duty Magistrate within the time specified and files a regular bail application, the same be decided on that day itself.

Arrest of the petitioner is stayed limited till 12.07.2018.

Petition stands disposed of .
