Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of F.I.R. No.103 dated 23.03.2017 registered under Sections 323, 452, 506 IPC at Police Station Madhuban, District Karnal (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 18.06.2018 (Annexure P-2).

This Court vide order dated 09.07.2018 had directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court to get their statements recorded and the learned Magistrate was directed to send its report qua the genuineness of the compromise.

Pursuant to the aforesaid order, parties have appeared before learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Karnal and got their statements

submitted report dated 16.08.2018 to the effect that the compromise is genuine and has been effected between the parties voluntarily and without any coercion or undue influence.

Respondent No.2-complainant, namely, Kavita Devi has made her statement with regard to compromise before learned Magistrate on 02.08.2018 to the effect that she has compromised the matter with the accused-Ram Nath with her own free will and without any pressure, coercion or influence.

Learned State counsel as well as learned counsel for respondent No.2 have not disputed the factum of compromise between the parties.

In view of the above, no useful purpose would be served to continue with the proceedings before the trial Court in the instant F.I.R.

Following the principles laid down by the Full Bench judgment of this Court in **Kulwinder Singh and others Versus State of Punjab and another 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052** and approved by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **Gian Singh Versus State of Punjab and others (2012) 10 SCC 303**, this petition is allowed and F.I.R. No.103 dated 23.03.2017 registered under Sections 323, 452, 506 IPC at Police Station Madhuban, District Karnal (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are quashed qua the petitioner on the basis of compromise dated 18.06.2018 (Annexure P-2).
