The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.65 dated 6.4.2018 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 420, 120-B, 315, 318 of Indian Penal Code (for short, "IPC") 3, 4, 5 of Medical Termination of Pregnancy Act, 1971, 4, 18, 23 of Pre-Natal Diagnostic Techniques (Regulation and Prevention of Misuse) Act, 1994 and 15(2)(B) of Indian Medical Council Act at Police Station City, Kharar, District SAS Nagar.

Heard.

Learned State counsel states that the allegation against the petitioner is that he was working as Lab Attendant in S.K.Multispeciality Hospital, Kharar.

Co-accused namely Sarabjit Kaur and Paramjit Kaur have already been granted benefit of regular bail by this Court in CRM-M-21377-

2018 and CRM-M-21583-2018 vide order dated 3.7.2018 and 25.5.2018 respectively. The petitioner is in custody since 6.5.2018.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that conclusion of trial will take considerably long time, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹ 50,000/- with one surety each to the satisfaction of the learned Area/Duty Magistrate and subject to the conditions, if so imposed, by that court.
