Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.161 dated 11.06.2017 under Sections 186, 307, 332, 353, 34 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Adampur, District Hisar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that there is no allegation against the petitioner that he has ever caused any injury to the complainant or anybody else. The only allegation against the petitioner is that he was found in company of Sachin and Vicky, the other co-accused. The allegation against Vicky is that he has given a knife blow on the person of Anil, whereas from the custody of Sachin a pistol of 32 bore was recovered. Petitioner is in custody since 11.06.2017 and there is no other case against him.

states that no doubt the petitioner has not caused injury to the complainant but he was present along with the other co-accused and he was driving the motorcycle. Therefore, involvement of the petitioner cannot be ruled out.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Considering the fact that in the FIR, there is no allegation against the petitioner that he has caused any injury to the complainant or anybody else but considering the fact that he is in custody since 11.06.2017, this Court finds that the petitioner deserves to be admitted on bail. Moreover, trial in the case will take long time as prosecution evidence is yet to start.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is admitted on regular bail, subject to furnishing of his bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.
