ARVIND SINGH SANGWAN, J. (ORAL):

Prayer in this petition is for issuance of a direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to constitute a Special Investigating Team (SIT) to look into the complaints made against respondent Nos.9 to 13.

Reply by way of affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Jagadhri (Yamuna Nagar), dated 11/14.12.2018, on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4 has been filed in the Court today and the same is taken on record.

As per the affidavit, a similar petition i.e.CRM-M-27130-2017 filed by similarly situated complainants namely Rakesh Saini and others was disposed of by this Court, vide order dated 14.11.2018. The operative part of the order dated 14.11.2018 reads as under:

“Learned State counsel submits that the instant petition has rendered infructuous, in view of the fact that the prayer made in the instant petition by the petitioners

had already been acceded to and FIR No. 1167 dated 26.07.2017, under Sections 420, 106, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC, Police Station City Jagadhri, was registered against the private respondents.

In view of the above, the instant petition is dismissed as having rendered infructuous.

It is further explained in the affidavit that after registration of the FIR, the police has constituted an SIT and the efforts are made for arresting the accused persons as detailed in the affidavit.

It is further stated that one Lakhwinder Singh has joined the investigation and the SIT has got the warrant of arrest of accused Neeraj Arora from the Judicial Magistrate First Class, Yamuna Nagar at Jagadhri. Therefore, the SIT is conducting the investigation.

In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous, at this stage. Liberty is granted to the petitioner to file a fresh petition, if so required.
