In the instant petition, petitioner has sought for anticipatory bail under the provision of Section 438 Cr.P.C in case FIR No.43 dated 03.05.2018 registered under Sections 420 at Police Station Dhariwal, Tehsil and District Gurdaspur.

2. The allegations against the petitioner is that petitioner is stated to have duped the complainant in respect of getting loan of Rs.1,00,000/- and complainant has been cheated to the extent of Rs.52,000/- as is evident from the allegations that complainant has received a sum of Rs.48,000/- against loan of Rs.1,00,000/-. Even the allegations are against the petitioner and one Brijpal who is stated to be an employee of the concerned Branch of the Bank.

3. Having regard to the serious allegations against the petitioner in respect of obtaining loan and not paying the entire amount to the complainant, petitioner has not made out a case so as to seek the concession of anticipatory bail as custodial interrogation is required for verification of certain facts and recovery of the duped amount.

4. Accordingly, petition stands dismissed.
