Present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been filed praying for quashing of the order dated 23.05.2009, passed by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Jalandhar (**Annexure P-3**), vide which, the petitioner was declared as a proclaimed offender in FIR No.367 dated 11.10.2007, under Sections 323, 341, 506, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Division No.6, Jalandhar.
