Present petition has been filed for seeking anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Cr.P.C. in Crl.Complaint No.COMI/0000358/2014 dated 27.12.2011 for the offences punishable under Section 326, 324, 323, 34, IPC registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Batala District Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the other co-accused in the trial has already been acquitted by the Trial Court. However, the present petitioner could not face the trial at the relevant time because he was out of country. For same reason, he was declared as proclaimed person also. However, the petitioner has no intention to flee from the course of justice. Hence the petitioner prays that he be protected from arrest so that he can appear before the Court.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Shri Hittan Nehra, Addl.AG, Punjab who is present in Court accepts notice on behalf of State of Punjab. Copy of the petition is handed over to the learned State counsel.

Although it is a complaint case, yet since the matter is before the Trial Court, therefore, notice to the complainant in the present proceedings is dispensed with.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction that in case the petitioner appears or is brought before the Court, he be released on interim bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds/surety to the satisfaction of Trial Court.
