In this application the petitioner prays for being released on an interim bail in case FIR No.99, dated 27.05.2014 registered under Section 22/61/85 of the NDPS Act, at Police Station Salem Tabri, District Ludhiana City, on the special ground that to attend the marriage ceremonies of his own daughter which are to be performed on 17th-18th of this month.

2. Ld. Counsel for the State on instructions ASI Jagdev Singh submits that after verification it has been found that the marriage in question is actually fixed.

3. In the circumstances, purely on humanitarian grounds the petitioner at this stage is permitted to be released on an interim bail to the satisfaction of the Ld. Special Court concerned, subject to imposition of appropriate terms and conditions, and the interim bail shall be operated from the morning of 16th February till the evening of 19th February, after which the petitioner shall be required to surrender himself in the concerned jail where he is presently lodged.
