Through the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr. P.C., the petitioner seeks regular bail in case FIR No.851, dated 17.09.2017, registered under Sections 398/401 of IPC and 25/54/59 of the Arms Act at Police Station Chandni Bagh Panipat, District Panipat(Annexure P-1).
