Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that even as per the reply filed on behalf of the State, it has been stated that neither is the car in which his co-accused are stated to have been apprehended with the opium, registered in the petitioner's name, nor even is the mobile phone, on the basis of which telephone calls are stated to have been exchanged with co-accused Rinku Kumar, shown to be that of petitioner, but of one Sheetal son of Balbir Singh.

That being so, without making any comment whatsoever on the actual involvement of the petitioner in the crime alleged, which would be gone into by the trial Court, a report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. already having been filed, this petition is disposed of with the order dated 17.08.2017, admitting the petitioner to bail, made absolute.
