The petitioner herein has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 234 dated 29.5.2018, under Section 306 IPC registered at Police Station City Tohana, District Fatehabad.

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case and, in fact, there is no evidence to prove that the petitioner ever abetted the deceased to commit suicide and the complainant himself has stated in the FIR that the deceased was suffering from illness for the past long time and his brother—Prem had got her treated from many places but her disease could not be cured. The trial is likely to take some time. No useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind bars till the conclusion of the trial. He prays

that the petitioner be admitted to regular bail.

Ms. Gaganpreet Kaur, learned AAG, Haryana, opposes the bail application, while submitting that the allegations levelled against the petitioner are of serious nature.

Without going into the merits of the case and keeping in view the nature of allegations and the fact that the trial is likely to take some time to conclude, the present petition is accepted and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
