The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in FIR No.62 dated 20.07.2016, under Sections 354, 363, 366, 376, 420, 465, 468, 511, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code and Section 25/27 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Sarabha Nagar, Ludhiana City.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that pursuant to the order dated 09.07.2018 passed by this court, the petitioners herein have joined the proceedings before the trial court and furnished the requisite bail bonds and surety bonds, which facts is not disputed by learned State counsel.

In view of the facts that the petitioners have joined the

proceedings before the trial court and furnished the requisite bail bonds, at this stage, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 09.07.2018 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
