1. In the instant petition, petitioner has prayed for the following relief:-

“It is therefore respectfully prayed for issuance of directions to official respondents to take legal action against the accused persons in FIR No. 0032, dated 15.04.2018 under Sections 336, 427, 148, 149 of IPC and 25, 27 of Arms Act, 1959, later on added Section 452 IPC dated 16.04.2018, registered at Police Station Kotbahi, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

Issue directions for protection of life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members at the hands of accused persons who are roaming freely and have not been arrested till date.”

2. Perusal of status report dated 23.10.2018 of Sh. Manjeet Singh Dhesi, PPS, Senior Superintendent of Police, Sri Muktsar Sahib, necessary action has been taken in appointing Investigating Officer who is conducting

inquiry which is evident in para no.8 of status report. The concerned police officer is hereby directed to complete the inquiry within a period of six weeks from today.

3. Further, petitioner has sought for protection of his life and liberty and his family members. In this regard, concerned police officer is hereby directed to extend protection to the petitioner. The outcome of the inquiry be made known to the petitioner by furnishing copy of inquiry report as and when it is completed in order to enable him to take further action, if inquiry is adverse to the petitioner.

5. With the above observations, instant petition stands disposed of.
