This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3 for conducting fair and impartial inquiry into representations dated 30.4.2018 and 1.6.2018 (Annexures P-2 and P-3)

Learned counsel for petitioner submits that he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the concerned authorities to consider and decide representation (Annexure P-3) in a time bound manner.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana respondents No.3 to consider and decide representation (Annexure P-3) within a period of 90 days from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. He is further directed to submit status report before concerned Chief Judicial Magistrate who will monitor the investigation in accordance with the guidelines laid down by Hon'ble Supreme Court in **Lalita Kumari v. Government of U.P. and others**; 2013 (4) RCR (Criminal) 979.
