Prayer in this case is for quashing of order dated 11.12.2017 whereby the petitioner has been declared a proclaimed person.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was not aware of the proceedings against her. The service report made to the Court by the serving constable is also factually incorrect. Learned counsel further submits that the petitioner does not want to flee from the court of justice. She intends to appear before the Court. Only prayer is that she be protected from arrest.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. K.S. Aulakh, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State. Copy of paper-book has been supplied to him.

Since the petitioner has expressed her desire to appear before the Court, therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. The impugned order dated 11.12.2017 is set aside and it is directed that in case the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court on or before 07.08.2018, she shall be released on bail by the trial Court on her furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to its satisfaction.

However, it is made clear that in case the petitioner does not surrender before the Court on the afore-mentioned date, no benefit shall flow to the petitioner from this order.
