JAISHREE THAKUR, J. (Oral)

The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.453 dated 26.05.2017, under Sections 323, 498-A, 506 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Ballabgarh City, District Faridabad, Haryana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is falsely implicated in the present case and on the direction of this Court, has joined the investigation. It is also contended that nothing is to be recovered from him.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Investigating

Officer, submits that petitioner has joined the investigation and most of the dowry articles have been recovered.

In view of the facts that the petitioner herein has joined the investigation and most of the dowry articles have been recovered from him, at this stage, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 28.07.2017 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
