This is a petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.30, dated 17.01.2017, under subsequent added Sections 420/406/120-B of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Ambala City.

3. There is no tangible material to support the allegations made in the F.I.R., nor is there any direct or indirect mention even in the disputed Agreement to Sell, or any other document.

4. Even otherwise, this Court is not inclined to lend much

credence to the allegation that the complainant, inspite of being a 72 years old man, was allured into entering a property deal in which possibility of huge profits was shown to him.

5. Consequently, the interim bail granted to the petitioner earlier is confirmed.
