GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner seeks quashing of FIR No.24 dated 03.12.2014 under Sections 419, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, Police Station NRI, District Ludhiana and proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.

Vide order dated 10.07.2018 the parties had been directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate so as to get the statements recorded with regard to the genuineness of the compromise.

Report of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ludhiana has

been received to the effect that statement of Jagjinder Singh attorney of complainant Joginder Kaur has been recorded who has stated that Joginder Kaur is his mother-in-law and has executed a Special Power of Attorney in his favour and a copy thereof has been annexed as Ex.CA. He has specifically deposed that Joginder Kaur has compromised the matter with accused-Rajdeep Singh out of her free will and she has no objection in case, the FIR and subsequent proceedings are quashed. To a similar effect is a statement of the petitioner/accused Rajdeep Singh who has also stated that he has compromised the matter with the complainant. Learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ludhiana has specifically opined that all the parties have compromised the matter voluntarily without there being any undue influence, coercion, threat or inducement.

In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the petition is allowed and FIR No.24 dated 03.12.2014 under Sections 419, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, Police Station NRI, District Ludhiana and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
