Petitioner has sought for the following relief:

*“Petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure with a prayer that directions may kindly be issued for transfer of the investigation of the case bearing FIR No.199 dated 18.4.2014 under section 279/337 and 304-A IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Charkhi Dadri, District Bhiwani from local police to the Crime Bureau of Investigation (CBI) or any other independent and impartial agency as the investigation in the hands of local police is ex-facie, unfair, tainted and defective.”*

2. In support of the petitioner's grievance, he has not approached the competent authority who is empowered to determine whether it is a fit case for transfer of investigation from local police to CBI or any other independent agency. In the absence of approaching competent authority like DGP, IGP or any other higher authority who is empowered with the shifting of investigation from local police to any other agency, no direction can be issued in respect of the petitioner's grievance.

3. Accordingly, petition stands dismissed. Dismissal of this petition would not come in the way of the petitioner to approach the

competent authority within a period of two weeks from today. Thereafter, competent authority is hereby directed to pass a speaking order on the petitioner's representation and communicate the same to the petitioner at the earliest.
