The present petition has been filed by the petitioner for grant of bail pending trial in case FIR No.467 dated 22.10.2017 registered under Sections 21/29/61/85 of NDPS Act at Police Station Ambala City.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that name of the petitioner is not mentioned in the FIR. He was named only in the disclosure statement of the co-accused. Nothing is recovered from him. It is further submitted that even the main accused, from whom, recovery in the present case was effected has already been released on bail by the trial Court.

Learned State Counsel, being instructed by ASI Balkar Singh, does not dispute the above said facts. However, counsel submits that there is another case of NDPS Act against the petitioner.

Be that as it may. The fact remains that in the present case, the person from whom recovery was effected, has been granted bail. Therefore, in view of the statement made by the counsel, but without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. The petitioner is

ordered to be released on bail pending trial on his furnishing bail bonds/
surety to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
