The present petition has been filed by the petitioner for grant of bail pending trial in case FIR No.110 dated 05.05.2018 registered under Section 22 of NDPS Act at Police Station Maloya, Chandigarh.

Counsel for the petitioner relies upon an order passed by the co-ordinate Bench of this Court in CRM-M No.4669 of 2018 – Sabir Mohd. @ Gollu v. State of Punjab decided on 09.02.2018 wherein the person from whom 35 voils of the same injections were recovered, which have been recovered from the petitioner, was granted concession of bail.

In view of the above, but without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. It is ordered that the petitioner shall be released on bail pending trial on his furnishing bail bonds/ surety to the satisfaction of the trial Court/ Duty Magistrate.
