The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.200 dated 29.8.2016 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 392, 382 of Indian Penal Code (for short, "IPC") and 25, 27 of Arms Act and Section 120-B IPC and 54, 59 of Arms Act added later on at Police Station Rama Mandi, Jalandhar.

Heard.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the co-accused has already been granted regular bail in CRM-M-2566 of 2017 vide order dated 20.12.2017 and that the petitioner is in custody since 3.9.2016.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that conclusion of trial will take considerably long time, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner-Sukhwinder Singh @ Babi son of Surjit Singh is ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of trial Court/Chief Judicial

- (a) The petitioner shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.
- (b) In the event of his absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioner shall stand withdrawn. The trial Court shall be competent to cancel his bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure his presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioner shall have to apply for bail afresh.
- (c) He shall not leave the country without the previous permission of the Court.
