In the instant petition, petitioner has sought for regular bail under the provision of Section 439 Cr.P.C in case FIR No.78 dated 15.03.2017 registered under Section 25 of Arms Act and Sections 148, 149, 452, 506, 302 IPC at Police Station Sadar Ballabgarh, District Faridabad.

2. Petitioner is in custody since 18.03.2017.

3. Having regard to the role of the petitioner stated in the FIR, it is only with reference to Section 34 IPC. That apart co-accused namely Gajab Singh @ Gajju has been extended the benefit of regular bail vide CRM-M-21532-2018; decided on 31.05.2018 (Annexure P-5). Thus, petitioner is entitled for regular bail and the trial would take some more time for the purpose of examination of the witnesses, hence, petitioner-Sumit alias Nate is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of concerned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.

4. However, the petitioner shall not in any way indulge in any criminal activities and he shall also not influence the witnesses or otherwise

interfere with the fair trial.

5. The petitioner shall also appear before the Station House Officer concerned on the last Saturday of every month at about 10.00 A.M.

6. Petition is allowed accordingly.
