Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.13 dated 24.01.2018 under Sections 379A, 34 IPC and Section 411 IPC (added later on) registered at Police Station GRP, Chandigarh, District GRP Ambala Cantt.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to order dated 11.07.2018 of this Court, the petitioner has joined investigation and recovery has been effected from other co-accused Mukesh.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Ajay Kaushal, does not dispute that the petitioner has joined investigation. He further submits that custodial interrogation of the petitioner is no more required.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Considering the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is no more required, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 11.07.2018 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when directed by the investigating agency and shall abide by the terms and conditions laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
