Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.35 dated 08.06.2017 under Sections 406, 420, 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Naya Gaon, District SAS Nagar, Mohali.

Vide order dated 11.12.2017, the matter was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court and the same has been amicably settled between the parties. As per this settlement, the petitioner has handed over three cheques of Rs.1.00 lac each to the complainant, photocopy of which is taken on record.

Counsel for the complainant has submitted that it may be clarified that in case the cheques are not honoured on the due date, liberty may be

granted to the complainant to revive this petition.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jasbir Singh, has however submitted that petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 31.07.2017 is made absolute subject to the condition that three cheques of Rs.1 lac each given by the petitioner to the complainant will be honoured and in case the same are dishonoured by the bank, it will be open for the complainant to move an appropriate application for revival of the present petition.

Disposed of, accordingly.
