In this petition, petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail under the provisions of Section 438 Cr.P.C. in FIR No.812 dated 30.06.2018 under Sections 427/453/506 IPC, registered at Police Station City Jagadhri, District Yamuna Nagar.

2.) Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that insofar as first petitioner is concerned, she is stated to have been arrested. Therefore, present petition do not survive for consideration qua first petitioner.

3.) Accordingly, petition stands disposed of as infructuous qua first petitioner-Priyanka Batra.

4.) This Court vide order dated 17.07.2018 had directed petitioner

No.2 to join investigation and in the event of arrest by the Arresting Officer,

petitioner was ordered to be released on interim bail on his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer.

5.) Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Rakesh Kumar, submitted that in pursuance to the order dated 17.07.2018, petitioner No.2 appeared before the Arresting Officer and joined the investigation and she is co-operating in the investigation.

6.) In view of these facts and circumstances, without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, the order dated 17.07.2018, granting interim bail to petitioner No.2, is hereby made absolute. Petitioner No.2 shall remain bound by the conditions as envisaged in Section 438 (2) of Cr.P.C.

7.) Petitioner No.2 shall not in any way indulge in any criminal activities and she shall not influence the witnesses or otherwise interfere with the fair trial.

8.) Petition stands allowed.
