The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.7 dated 18.1.2018 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B of Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Division No.4, District Patiala.

Heard.

It has been submitted that Gurcharan Kaur submitted bail bonds in case FIR No.13 dated 22.1.2013 with regard to release of Satnam Singh-petitioner No.2 and she produced a fake copy of the jamabandi. Petitioner No.1 has identified said Gurcharan Kaur. However, Satnam Singh-petitioner No.2 was in jail.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Mukhtiar Singh states that the petitioners have joined the investigation.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed and the order dated 11.7.2018 is made absolute till the presentation of challan, subject to the following terms:-

- (i) that the petitioners shall make themselves available for interrogation by the police as and when required;
- (ii) that the petitioners shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the accusation against them so as to dissuade them from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;
- (iii) that the petitioners shall not leave India without the prior permission of the trial Court.
- (iv) that the petitioners will seek regular bail on the presentation of challan in Court.
