This is a second petition for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.244 dated 23.10.2017, registered at Police Station Sadar Jalandhar, under Sections 420, 464, 465, 467, 468, 470, 471, 472, 473 and 120-B IPC.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw this petition. He submits that the petitioner would surrender/appear before the investigating agency and cooperate with it. He would also move an application for grant of regular bail and the concerned Illaqa Magistrate/Court may be directed to decide the same within a limited time period.

The petition is dismissed as withdrawn.

The petitioner is directed to surrender/appear before the concerned Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court on or before 18.07.2018 and move an application for grant of regular bail. On his doing so and moving such an application, the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court shall decide the same within three days and grant him regular bail subject to its satisfaction.
