Present petition has been filed for seeking bail pending trial under Section 439 of the Cr.P.C. in the FIR No. 395 dated 14.12.2017 under Sections 307/120B/216 IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Narnaund, District Hisar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that even as per the case of the prosecution, the petitioner is not the person who caused injuries to anybody. He is in custody since 14.12.2017 and the evidence is yet to start.

On the other hand, learned State counsel, being instructed from ASI Lalit, submits that pistol is recovered from the petitioner. The petitioner is also involved in one more case having the criminal antecedents.

In view of the above, without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. It is ordered that the petitioner be released on bail pending trial, on his furnishing bail bonds/surety to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
