Prayer in the instant petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of the FIR along with all consequential proceedings therefrom on the basis of compromise entered into between the parties.

Vide order dated 31.07.2017, this Court had directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court for recording their respective statements with regard to compromise/settlement on 24.08.2017. In pursuance thereof, a communication has been received from Judicial Magistrate 1st Class Jagraon, that though the parties were directed to appear to get their statements recorded in terms of the compromise, however, none has appeared on behalf of the parties on 24.08.2017 and even thereafter, they have not made any effort to get their statements recorded in support of the compromise.

In view of the said report of the Judicial Magistrate 1st Class Jagraon, this Court finds that there is no compromise between the parties.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed at this stage.

However, in case the parties arrive at a fresh compromise or intend to challenge the FIR on merits, they are at liberty to file a fresh petition.
