The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. with a prayer to issue directions to respondents No. 2 and 3 to protect the lives and liberty of the petitioners and also to direct respondents No. 4 and 5 not to interfere in the personal lives and liberty of the petitioners.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Ashima Mor, Addl. P.P., U.T., Chandigarh, accepted notice on behalf of the official respondents.

The matter was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court as respondent No. 5, mother of petitioner No. 1, was present in Court. The Mediator has recorded the statement of petitioner No. 1 as well as her mother i.e. respondent No. 5 Sunita Devi. In the statement, respondent No. 5 has stated that she has no objection with the marriage of the petitioners.

In view of the same, this petition is disposed of by issuing a direction to respondent No. 2-Senior Superintendent of Police, U.T.,

Chandigarh to look into the grievances of the petitioners for providing protection to their lives and liberty, if required.
