This petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of
Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case
FIR No. 88 dated 11.06.2017, under Sections 307/34 IPC read with Section
25/54/59 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Sadar Patti, District
Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the very outset, submits
that the matter stands compromised between the parties and has relied upon
affidavit of complainant Nishan Singh (Annexure P-4), who is present in
Court. It is also submitted that petitioner is not involved in any other case.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Gurbaksh Singh, has verified the aforesaid fact from complainant Nishan Singh, who has been identified as the complainant by the ASI Gurbaksh Singh. Learned State counsel has also filed custody certificate and as per the same, the petitioner is not involved in any other case.

In view of the above, without commenting upon the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds and two sureties of the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
