Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and the complainant has even filed a suit for possession by way of specific performance of the alleged agreement to sell executed by the petitioner in favour of the deceased-Sukhmander Singh, husband of the complainant.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sewak Singh, has not disputed that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for further investigation.

A perusal of the record submitted by the trial Court shows that despite issuance of notice, no one has appeared on behalf of respondent No.2- complainant before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed. The order dated 01.08.2017, passed by this Court, is made absolute.
