JAISHREE THAKUR, J. (Oral)

This is a petition that has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C for setting aside/quashing of impugned order dated 23.03.2017, rectified on 28.4.2017 passed by the trial Court vide which application under Section 311 Cr.P.C of the petitioner has been dismissed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that matter has been compromised between the parties which fact has not been disputed by the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents.

It is not in dispute that in terms of the compromise, petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act has been filed and a part payment of ₹ 10,20,000/- has been received by the petitioner herein.

In view of the fact that compromise has been arrived at between the parties and it has been agreed that FIR would be quashed as and when petition filed under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act attains finality, no further orders are called for in this petition and the same is rendered infructuous.

Accordingly, petition stands disposed of. However, in case terms and conditions of the compromise are not adhered to, petitioner is at liberty to revive the instant petition.
