This is a petition filed under Section 438 Cr. P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.1047 dated 16.11.2016 under Sections 420,467,468,469,471,120-B IPC, registered at Police Station City, District Hissar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that although on previous hearing, the petitioner had undertaken to pay an amount of Rs.2.5 lakhs to the bank, however, she could pay only an amount of Rs.1 lakh which has been deposited with the bank on 13.11.2018. It is further submitted that the bank has already initiated proceedings before the Debt Recovery Tribunal for recovery of the alleged outstanding amount. Therefore, dispute regarding payment would be decided by the Tribunal only. So far as the present proceedings are concerned, the petitioner has already joined the investigation.

On the other hand, learned State counsel, being instructed by SI Shamsheer Singh has not disputed the fact that the petitioner has already joined the investigation and that the petitioner is no more required for any further investigation.

Learned counsel for the Bank submits that as per the Bank record, as on 31.10.2018, an amount of Rs.4,99,645/- is still outstanding against the petitioner.

Be that as it may, fact remains that the petitioner has already joined the investigation and she is not required for any further investigation purposes.

In view of the above, but without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 04.10.2018, passed by this Court, is made absolute.
