The present petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No.66 dated 10.05.2017, registered at Police Station Dayalpura, District Bathinda, under Sections 452, 323, 506, 148 and 149 IPC on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2).

Pursuant to order dated 11.07.2018, report dated 10.08.2018 has been received from the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Phul, according to which, the statements of the parties have been recorded and the compromise is genuine and has been arrived at between them without any pressure or coercion.
