The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. For grant of regular bail in case FIR No.780 dated 23.10.2015, registered under Sections 148, 149, 342, 302, 323, 506, 120-B IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, at Police Station Sadar, District Karnal.

Heard.

The bail is sought on the ground that one of the eye witness has turned hostile. The trial is in progress. No ground for grant of bail is made out.

As such, the instant petition stands dismissed. However, the trial court is directed to expedite the trial by giving short adjournments and conclude it as early as possible preferably within a period of three months from the date fixed before that Court.
