Petitioners Jyoti Bala and Rahul have averred that they have married against wishes of respondents No.4 and 5, who are brothers of petitioner No.1. The petitioners have annexed copies of their Aadhar Cards indicating that petitioners are aged 21 years and 22 years.

The petitioners apprehend threat to their life and liberty at the hands of respondents No.4 and 5 and thus seek issuance of appropriate directions.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Gurdaspur, District Gurdaspur to look into the representation dated 10.7.2018 (Annexure P-4) made by petitioner No.1, in accordance with law, immediately upon receipt of certified copy of this order. In case any serious apprehension of threat to the life and liberty of the petitioners is found, requisite steps be taken immediately, in accordance with law, to protect life and liberty of the petitioners.
